

# Australian Frogs

List of changes between Scythebill Australian Frogs list v1 (November 2016) and v2 (November 2021)

1. Split *Assa darlingtoni* by adding *Assa wollumbin* Mahony, Hines, Mahony, Moses, Catalano, Myers, and Donnellan, 2021, Mount Wollumbin Hip-pocket Frog. This is found only on Mount Wollumbin (Mount Warning) in northern NSW. Revised common name of *A. darlingtoni* to Hip-Pocket Frog for consistency.
2. Added new species *Uperoleia gurrumuli* Catullo and Keogh, 2021, Gurrumul's Toadlet, found only in the Wessel Island chain, northeastern Northern Territory.
3. Added new species, *Uperoleia mahonyi* Clulow, Anstis, Keogh, and Catullo, 2016, Mahony's Toadlet, found between Norah Head and Seal Rocks, NSW
4. Split *Litoria gracilenta* by adding *Litoria bella* (McDonald, Rowley, Richards, and Frankham, 2016), Cape York Graceful Tree Frog. *Bella* occurs north of Stuart River on Cape York Peninsula, Qld. Records from Cooktown south remain as *gracilenta*.
5. Split *Litoria littlejohni* by adding *Litoria watsoni* Mahony, Moses, Mahony, Lemckert, and Donnellan, 2020, Southern Heath Tree Frog. Common name of *littlejohni* becomes Northern Heath Tree Frog. Records south of Macquarie Pass, NSW, should be assigned to *watsoni*.
6. Split *Litoria watjulumensis*, Watjulum Frog by resurrecting *Litoria spaldingi*, Spalding's Rocket Frog, following Donnellan et al (2021). *Watjulumensis* is found in Western Australia and west of the Victoria River in the Northern Territory; frogs in the rest of the NT and Queensland are *spaldingi*.
